Bhūmī (Sanskrit: भूमि) is the 32 and 33 place (10 and 11 in simple count) on the outgoing's process of Mahayana awakening. In Buddhism, initially the monks who arrived at Bhūmī were called Ārjavakas in opposition to Brahminism. Āśakra devānām and Trāyastriṅśā are together called "Bhūmī nivāsin".. The Sanskrit term bhūmī literally means "ground" or "foundation".
